Dear County EC, Club Official,

As you are all aware, this Saturday October 11th will be the ENY ARES/RACES Simulated Emergency Test. I am not going to go into details here, although I have attached them to this e-mail.

Since currently we are still using K2CT as our district wide repeater, I would like to go over the plan for Saturday. K2CT will be active with Albany County check-ins from 9 AM until 10:30 AM. The Net Control will be John Farina W2QCY. A few minutes after 10:30 a district wide net will be activated and run until 11:30 (or until I have all counties checked in with their accumulated scores). I will be net control at that time. I can take your report either verbally or via NBEMS. At 11:30, the district net will close, so that I can upload the district scores to KM2O on the N2ACF system before noon. This mirrors what we did last time and it worked OK.

Counties that have traffic to pass during the 90+ minutes from 9 AM to 10:30AM will find me on the Albany simplex frequency of 146.58. I will be NCS for the Albany simplex test. When not busy I may check into other nets within the district. Tom Woznack N2SQW has volunteered to act as a liaison between nets. If you have already appointed a net liaison for your operation, great! I will be asking Tom to pass some traffic between counties. We also have Arnie Koeppen who can pass some traffic out of the area on the NYSTEPN. Traffic counts as points for the total score.

I have the frequencies of some counties but would like to confirm who will be where so I can pass this along to Tom N2SQW.
